You will be motivated to use the German language by improving language skills, creating an understanding of the German grammar and a solid vocabulary and a methodical training of pronunciation.

Time: 4 SWS (4 hours per week) during the winter term (October – February)

Date: every Tuesday and Thursday from 6 until 8 p.m.

Conditions for attendance:

- Non-German nationality
- No language experiences expected
- Matriculation as PhD student with/without planned disputation at HU, letter of acceptance from Humboldt Graduate School or the Promotionsbüros (offices dealing with dissertations) of the respective faculty of the HU.

Costs: free of charge for those participating regularly
(minimum time of participation: 80%)
